

# NO WEAPONS POLICY

Allen Park Housing Commission's policy prohibiting possession of any weapons on Allen Park Housing Commission Premises is as follows:

The Allen Park Housing Commission has considered the safety of its residents and hereby establishes a clear policy that specifically addresses and prohibits weapons on the premises of the Allen Park Housing Commission.

The Allen Park Housing Commission prohibits all persons who enter Allen Park Housing Commission property from carrying a handgun, firearm, or prohibited weapon of any kind onto the property, regardless of whether the person is licensed to carry the weapon or not.

This policy and its prohibitions applies to all Allen Park Housing Commission employees, contract and temporary employees, residents, and visitors on Allen Park Housing Commission property, as well as contractors on Allen Park Housing Commission property, as well as contractors on Allen Park Housing Commission property, regardless of whether or not they are licensed to carry a concealed weapon. The only exceptions to this policy are Law Enforcement Officers as defined by state law. This policy also prohibits weapons at any Allen Park Housing Commission sponsored functions such as parties, picnics, meetings, etc.

"Weapons" which are not allowed on the Allen Park Housing Commission premises include any form of weapon or explosive restricted under local, state, or federal regulations. This includes all firearms, illegal knives or other weapons covered by the law. Legal, chemical dispensing devices such as pepper sprays that are sold commercially for personal protection are not covered by this policy. If anyone affected by this policy has a question about whether an item is covered by this policy, please contact the Executive Director. Tenants and other persons affected by this policy are responsible for making sure that any potentially covered item that the affected individual possesses is not prohibited by this policy.

Allen Park Housing Commission property covered by this policy includes, without limitation, all Allen Park Housing Commission owned buildings, surrounding areas such as sidewalks, walkways, driveways, and parking lots under the Allen Park Housing Commission ownership or control. Allen Park Housing Commission vehicles are covered by this policy at all times regardless of whether they are on Allen Park Housing Commission property at the time.

The Allen Park Housing Commission reserves the right to conduct searches of any person, vehicle or object that enters onto Allen Park Housing Commission property consistent with the law.

# NO WEAPONS POLICY

Those who wish to admit, explain, or deny ownership of any discovered weapon prohibited by this policy will be given the opportunity for an informal conference with the Executive Director or the Commission's attorney. If a violation of this policy is upheld by an appropriate authority of the Allen Park Housing Commission, the carrying of a weapon onto Allen Park Housing Commission property in violation of this policy will be considered an act of criminal trespass and will be grounds for immediate removal from the Allen Park Housing Commission property, and may result in prosecution and/or the institution of eviction proceedings against any offending tenant.

THIS POLICY SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO CREATE ANY DUTY OR OBLIGATION ON THE PARTY OF THE ALLEN PARK HOUSING COMMISSION TO TAK ANY ACTION BEYOND THOSE REQUIRED BY EXISTING LAW.

If you become aware of anyone violating this policy, please report it to management staff immediately.

## ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF WEAPONS POLICY

I hereby acknowledge that I have read and understand the Allen Park Housing Commission's No Weapons Policy. I understand that engaging in prohibited behavior under this policy may result in removal from the Allen Park Housing Commission premises, termination of my tenancy and legal action. I agree to uphold the Allen Park Housing Commission's No Weapons Policy.
